

**Safety Improvement area:** School district

**Problem:** Difficulty to change inhabitants' behaviour, stigmas associated with mobility, congestion, parking issues

**Measures:** Offer free train usage for Jūrmala citizens, conduct educational workshops on alternative transport usage and safe traffic practices, implement data-based traffic reorganisation, develop a city-wide mobility plan

**Goals:** Encourage the use of public transport and active mobility modes, while reducing traffic congestion during peak drop-off and pick-up hours

**Target groups:** Local residents, children, driving parents and car drivers

**Stakeholders:** City departments, schools, kindergartens, the Youth Centre, e-scooters and car-sharing services, NGOs, neighbourhood associations.

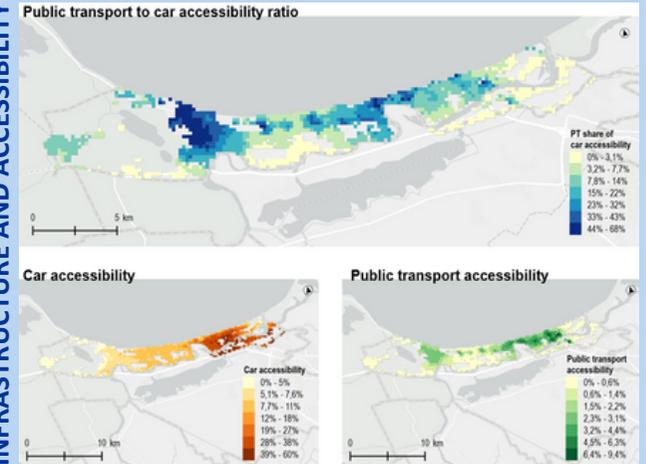

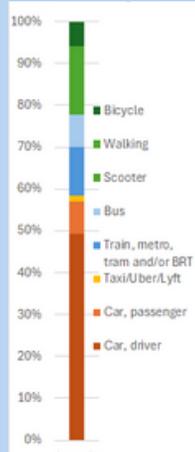
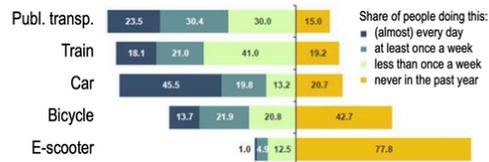
